DO NOT CHEAT	You will receive a ZERO on any assignment that is not your OWN work
DO NOT COPY FROM ANYONE OR ANYTHING – this includes copying words from a dictionary, the internet, another student, etc.	You will receive a ZERO on any assignment that is not your OWN work
Follow directions on all papers	You will lose points or receive no points for work done that is not according to the instructions.
Follow directions spoken by the teacher	You will fall behind in our class activities
Be nice to other students	Our class environment will not be good for learning
Be nice to yourself	You will not learn as quickly as you can

Name at the TOP of your paper	ZERO for the assignment
Title of assignment (when required)	ZERO for the assignment
Cover sheet (when required)	ZERO for the assignment
Torn edge of the paper is clean	ZERO for the assignment
Holes are on the LEFT side of the paper	ZERO for the assignment
Handwriting is <u>on the line</u>	ZERO for the assignment
Handwriting clearly has a space between all words	ZERO for the assignment

Grades

Rules	Consequences of breaking these rules
Keep all of your grades and graded papers in a folder titled "Grades"	You will not have evidence of your work if you want to discuss your grades with your teacher later.
Do not ask the teacher to "give" you a grade. Remember, you EARN your grades; they are not a gift	The teacher will not discuss this topic at all.
If you want to discuss your grades, come to the teacher's office	You cannot discuss your grades in any other situation
