

## More About the IPA! **DIFFICULT** CONSONANTS

In the alphabet listed below, you will see the **vowels in blue**. Each vowel may have many different vowel sounds. The **DIFFICULT consonants are in red**. Each **difficult consonant** may have more than one sound. Therefore, the IPA picture for these letters is different from the letter. Use the spaces below to write the IPA pictures for the difficult consonant sounds in American English.


The small black letters are the obvious consonants and the IPA picture for each of the sounds made by these letters looks like the letter.
