

More About the IPA! **OBVIOUS** CONSONANTS

In the alphabet listed below, you will see the **vowels in blue**. Each vowel may have many different vowel sounds. The **obvious consonants are in red**. Each **obvious consonant has one sound** and it is usually the sound you expect it to be. The IPA picture for these sounds is exactly like the letter. The small black letters below can have **different sounds**. (Wait for the next worksheet!)
